

Autumn Beer festival Description

The outdoor festival is to be held at Gull Lake Park in June Lake on October 5, 2013, from 10:00 am to 5:00pm. (weather permitting).

The day's events include a chili cook-off and pie baking contest. The winner of both of these contest will not only receive a small cash prize and gifts, but they will also earn the title of *The Eastern Sierras Chili Master and Pie Baking Champion*.

There will be food and drink vendors on site for the sale of food and drinks to the festival goers. Also, there will be craft vendors selling their goods, just in time for early holiday shopping. There will also be many games for children as well as the adults. These games will have prizes that range from the small and fun to actual cash prizes. A bounce house (\$1.00 fee) will be on site for the children to enjoy while the parents partake in the beer drinking, eating and the shopping.

The beer garden currently consists of three vendors at this time. Hopefully that amount will increase now that the event is "official". There is a possibility of a beer "chugging" contest with the grand prize being a handmade, one of a kind beer stein. Security will be on hand to control any of the festival goers who may get a little out of hand.

The theme for this autumn festival is the beautiful colors of fall. There will be pumpkins, scare crows and hay bales which will accent nature's burst of vivid colors.
